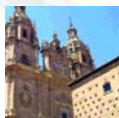
## Why Salamanca?

Location: Mid West of Spain in the region of Castilla y León

### LECTURES (FREE)

Each week from 13:00 to 14:00hrs. and from 19:00 to 20:00 lectures are given: Mondays-"Regions of Spain"; Tuesdays-"Traditions and Legends of Spain"; Wednesdays - "Spanish History"; Thursdays-"Spanish Art".

These lectures introduce the student to Spanish culture through our history, art, literature and economics, thus helping the student to have a better understanding of our current society.

### DIPLOMA (FREE)

On the last Thursday of every month there is a test for you to see how much you have learnt. Also each month, the teachers hand in a report on the progress of each student to the Director of Studies (continuous evaluation). Once you finish your course and have passed both forms of assessment, you will receive a diploma from "Colegio Delibes", stating your level of Spanish and your test result. Only students who have completed at least one level (four weeks) will receive a diploma. Should a student not pass the assessments, they will receive a course attendance certificate.

Those students who continue to study, after passing the assessments, will advance to the next learning stage the following month.

In order to obtain either the diploma or the certificate, and also to be able to advance to the next level, it is compulsory to have attended a minimum of 90% of the classes.



Note: The start date of each level (the first working day of each month), is indicated in the enrollment form.

Students who start at the college after the first week of the month may join a course which has already started at their corresponding level.

### TUTORIALS (FREE)

If a student cannot keep up with the learning pace of his/her fellow students, or has not understood a topic very well, they can be given an extra individual class with new explanations and exercises. The objective of the tutorials is to ensure that all of the groups have the same level of learning and are equally intense and beneficial for everyone.

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### COURSE A. INTENSIVE SPANISH LANGUAGE

This is the most suitable course for the majority of students. An intensive course that allows you to learn quickly and to participate in the college's programmed activities where you will continue to learn. During the first two hours you will be taught various grammatical themes and they will be supported by a variety of exercises. These will include the correction of sentences, examples, structural work on texts... The following two hours will be devoted to conversational oral and written expression, vocabulary, idioms, comprehensions.

### COURSE B. INTENSIVE SPANISH LANGUAGE AND CULTURE

### COURSE H. BUSINESS SPANISH

An ideal course to expand your knowledge of commercial language. Designed for companies, executives, students of economics and tourism...

**1st hour:** Commercial correspondence, types of letters, CVs

**2nd hour:** Analysis and discussion of contemporary articles from specialized economic publications. Spain before the E.U., topics on Macro and Microeconomics.  
With afternoon classes you can also take a standard language course in the morning (Course A, B, C, D, E or F).

### COURSE I. PREPARATION FOR D.E.L.E. DIPLOMA

In Delibes we have two special courses for the preparation of D.E.L.E.  
• Intermedio D.E.L.E. • Superior D.E.L.E.

Each year we start the preparation for these two exams at the beginning of February and also at the beginning of September.  
During the first two hours of this class, theoretical and practical aspects of grammar will be studied. In the 3rd and 4th hours work will be done on specific aspects of the exam: reading and listening comprehensions, personal interviews, written skills essays, exercises on technical vocabulary.  
Some time before the test, past exams papers will be worked on in class as well as reading and listening comprehensions, and interviews.  
The D.E.L.E. (Diploma of Spanish as a foreign language) is the only official valid diploma recognized by the Spanish State. This exam can be taken in Spain or in Cervantes institutes and Spanish embassies in the rest of the world. It takes place twice a year in the middle of May and at the end of November, both intermedio and superior levels are taken during these months.

Students with a level below Intermediate must have had previous training before the beginning of the D.E.L.E. course to guarantee success in the exam. Students who miss two D.E.L.E. classes consecutively without being excused will automatically be transferred to a standard course A.

### COURSE J. INTENSIVE COURSE OF SPANISH LANGUAGE (MIXED GROUP)

The structure of this course is the same as course A, but the difference is that in this course there is a maximum of 4 students. The course is ideal for students with little free time and with a special interest in increasing their knowledge.

**2nd and 3rd hours:** (from 10:00 to 12:00 h): Conversation.

**4th hour:** (from 12:00 to 13:00 h): Cultural visits, lectures, presentations.

### COURSE M. SELECTIVITY COURSE

'Selectividad' is the exam (they are really 8 different ones) that Spanish students must take after high school if they want to go to university. Foreign students are also allowed to study in Spanish universities as long as they take this exam, just like Spanish students do. Colegio Delibes has recently signed a partnership with one of the best private schools in Salamanca which prepares students to pass these 'Selectividad' exams.

'Selectividad' is held twice a year, in June and in September.

- Spanish Language (5 hours per week).
- Criticism (2 hours per week).

**Starting date:** September, 20th. **Finishing date:** May, 30th.

\* In order to take this course students must have a minimum level of Upper Advanced in Spanish Language.

**Length of the course:** 32 weeks. There will be no lessons, due to national holidays: 2 weeks in Christmas and 2 weeks in Easter.

**Number of hours per week:** 19 hours.

**Total number of hours from September to May (both included):** 608 hours.

**Total price of the course:** 3,400.00 Euros (400 Euros/month, except September which is 200 Euros).

**This price includes:** Lessons. All the teaching materials: folder, photocopies, pen...

**Administration fees:** 150 Euros.

**Includes:** • Convivialization of Degree

- Exam fees

If the student did not pass the exam in June, he/she can retake it in September. The course to prepare the exam in September starts in July and will last two and a half months. The price will be 1000 euros (10 weeks, 190 hours of lessons). Classrooms will have a maximum of 7 students.

**On the first day of class all students must sit a classification test. With this test the Director of Studies will determine the level of the student and the class that they should attend.**





## accommodation

Accommodation is an essential part of our programme. When you decide to come to Delibes, you should only worry about one thing: sending us the enrolment form with all your personal details, the course you wish to do, the dates and your preferred accommodation. The day we receive your letter, fax or e-mail, we will send you a confirmation letter, the address of your accommodation and all the instructions you need so that you do not have any problems on your journey.

We offer our students five different possibilities for lodging in Salamanca during their course:

- With a Spanish host family.
- In a student residence.
- In a flat shared with other students.
- In a studio apartment (minimum 4 weeks).
- In a hotel or hostel.

All our families, like our flats, residences and the hotels that work with us, are located in the city centre, a maximum of 10 minutes' walk on foot to the Plaza Mayor and the school.

All the options have everything you need to live comfortably and enjoy a pleasant stay in Salamanca.

If a student is not entirely comfortable, for a reasonable reason, in the accommodation that we have assigned to him/her, they must tell the school secretary within the first three days of their stay and we will quickly find an alternative.

On the enrolment form you must state the start date of your course and the start date of your accommodation.



Normally courses begin on Mondays and students arrive on Saturdays or Sundays.

Students who arrive on the weekend will have no problems because the school is open on Sundays from 12:00 to 14:00 hrs. and at 16:00 hrs until 20:00 hrs.

Moreover, at the weekend we can always be contacted on our mobile telephone in order to sort out any problems with both newcomers and those students already in Salamanca.

## spanish families

All the families that take in Delibes students have been carefully chosen and we guarantee that they will treat you very well, with quality food and nice clean houses.

Living with a family has various advantages: you will learn for yourself about the customs, food, routines and way of life through your own experience. Living with a family gives you the chance to practise your Spanish all day long and at the same time expands your vocabulary and improves your pronunciation. In short, it is the best way to integrate fully into Spanish life. This type of accommodation is offered throughout the year.



There are four possibilities for living with families:

- Single room and full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner).
- Single room and half board (breakfast and lunch or dinner).
- Double room and full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner).
- Double room and half board (breakfast and lunch or dinner).

Students must bring their own towels. The family will provide blankets, sheets and duvets. On the first day the student will receive the key to the family house in order to be able to come and go as they wish.

Facilities for washing clothes are included in the price.

If the course that you are going to take lasts for a few months, we also offer you the opportunity to reserve mixed accommodation. For example, the first month with a family and then afterwards in a student flat or in a residence.



## student residences

The Colegio Delibes has its own residence in Salamanca. It is in the city centre, five minutes' walk from the Plaza Mayor and 10 minutes from the school.

It has 42 bedrooms, double and individual, three sitting rooms, a patio and all modern facilities.

In the residence students of all nationalities are put together, so that the atmosphere is a mixture of cultures where the students are enriched by acquiring experiences and anecdotes from all over the world.

Students must bring their own towels. The residence provides bedclothes.

There is accommodation in the residence throughout the year.

Limited places.

Four possibilities:

- Single room and full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner).
- Single room and half board (breakfast and lunch or dinner).
- Double room and full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner).
- Double room and half board (breakfast and lunch or dinner).

Facilities for washing clothes are included in the price.

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## shared flats

These flats have a double room and 2 or 3 single rooms, a bathroom, kitchen and sitting-room. They have central heating and hot water. They are equipped with the necessary furniture to make your stay pleasant and comfortable. All the bedrooms have a bed, a wardrobe, a desk and chair, a small table and shelves. The kitchen is supplied with all the necessary utensils (pots, pans, plates, glasses, etc.). All flats have a washing machine and a fridge. In the sitting room there is a large table on which to eat, a television, a sideboard cabinet and a sofa. Students must bring their own towels. The college provides bedclothes.



### There are two possibilities:

- Individual room.
- Double room.

This type of accommodation also has its advantages. As they are shared flats you will make friends quickly with other students from the college. In a flat you will enjoy greater freedom, but at the same time it is a big responsibility, as students must cook, keep the flat clean and act in line with the principles of having to live together.

Flats will be cleaned by the school minimum once a week.

Arrival day in flats: Sundays after 12:00 pm\*  
Leaving day: Saturdays by 12:00hr

\*If you arrive in Salamanca on Saturday, let us know and we will book a reasonably priced hotel for you at your cost.

## studios

These are small apartments for one or two people, with a bedroom (single or double), a bathroom, and an American kitchen connected to a small lounge.

If you choose this option, then you must reserve it well in advance, as we do not have many free studios.

\*If you arrive in Salamanca on Saturday, let us know and we will book a reasonably priced hotel for you at your cost.

## hotels

We have a large variety of hotels and hostels of different categories, prices and quality in Salamanca.

If you choose this option then you must contact us and we will give you a list of possibilities to choose from, depending on your requirements.

## activities

### ACTIVITY PROGRAMME

In Salamanca you can visit many art and sculpture exhibitions and museums such as La Casa Lis. You can also visit the theatre or go to concerts, lectures...

The city offers a great variety of things to do. On top of this, each month Colegio Delibes prepares a detailed programme of activities.

### THIS PROGRAMME INCLUDES SOME COMPLETELY FREE ACTIVITIES:

- A guided tour of the city on the first day of each month.
- Four lectures every week (art, history, Spanish regions).
- Four films in Spanish each week.
- Sport activities (tennis, bowling, ping-pong, basketball, football).
- Each week a party in a local pub-disco with one free drink.
- The use of internet in the college everyday.

### AND SOME ACTIVITIES AT A SMALL EXTRA PRICE:

- A farewell dinner on the last day of each month.
- Classes in traditional Spanish dances.
